Practice	What can we do?
1. Safe & Welcome Environment A. Hargraeves study — What does your teacher do that helps you learn? 1. My teacher likes me 2. My teacher doesn't compare me to a sibling 3. My teacher is organized My teacher likes me = my teacher knows me Relationship matters! EQAO Test — Safe Schools Survey found a correlation between how well a student did on the test and how safe they felt at school. Feeling safe matters!	 Meet & Greet – First impressions matter! Find the connection – similar interests? Feed children – (Maslow before Bloom) Be flexible – fluidity of time When appropriate, let the children lead Routine is good Surprise is also good Engagement = fun! Safety first, always Include family members Grace, mercy, love = Lead like Jesus
2. Clear & Focused Mission Why are we here? 'Elevator Mission Statement' For different audiences	We believe
3. Positive Home-Camp Relationship Building trust Accountable, Transparent, Consistent	Inform, invite, share
