JOHN 10, PSALM 23	<p>We are going to look at Jesus as our Good Shepherd today.</p> <p>What can you tell me about the work of a shepherd? (<i>must love the sheep, knows every one of the sheep, maybe each one has a name, takes good care of the sheep: cool, clean water to drink, protects them from danger (weather, wild animals), takes care of any sheep that gets hurt, makes sure they have lots of green grass to eat</i>)</p> <p>We’ve talked a lot about shepherds and what they do, but I want to talk a bit about the sheep right now.</p> <p>2. What do you know about sheep? <i>(need guidance, care, cute and loveable but not smart - rely on a shepherd to lead them to safety and food)</i></p> <p>We’re going to watch a video about Psalm 23 – and I want you to listen carefully. There are three things the shepherd does for the sheep. Watch and see if you can discover them. (Watch The Biggest Story #39: <i>The Lord is My Shepherd</i>)</p> <p><u>Storyboard Activity:</u> Using your storyboard, let’s see if we can identify the three things that the Good Shepherd does for us, his sheep.</p> <p>Can you name one thing the Good Shepherd does for us? <i>(lead, protect, lays down his life)</i></p> <p>Now we will fill in the second column, about us, the sheep.</p> <p>If we are letting Jesus, our Good Shepherd, lead us, what do we need to do? <i>(follow)</i></p> <p>If we need the protection of Jesus, what does that say about the sheep? <i>(we are easily distracted, lead astray, prone to wander)</i></p> <p>Why did Jesus die? <i>(to save us and redeem us from our sin)</i></p> <p>“I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd gives his life for the sheep.” (John 10:11) NIRV “Be their shepherd. Take care of them forever.” (Psalm 28:9) (NIRV)</p> <p>Psalm 23 is identified in the video as one of many songs in the Bible. 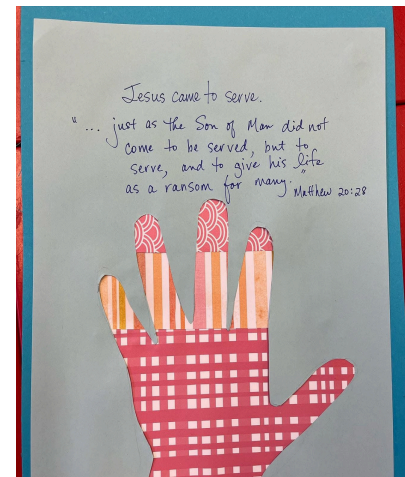

(Write down definition ideas) <i>(To do something nice for someone else who needs help in some way, to be kind to someone, to do something (work) for someone's benefit)</i></p> <p>What are some ways we can serve people today?</p> <p>What are some ways that Jesus served people during His ministry? <i>(Children suggest ideas. Draw. Write on whiteboard)</i></p> <p>We are going to watch a video about Jesus serving many people by feeding them. (Watch one or all three: Biggest Story video #66: <i>The Happy Meal that Kept on Going</i>, Biggest Story video #80: <i>A Meal for the Ages</i>, The Jesus StoryBook Bible: <i>Filled Full!</i>)</p> <p>Discuss Video:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • I think feeding people is a sacred and honourable thing to do - this story about Jesus is why I feel that way. Do you ever cook and feed your family? How do you feel when you do that? • Why did Jesus' disciples want to send the people away? • What does it tell you about Jesus that He insisted on feeding all of the people? • How did Jesus make a small amount of food enough for thousands of people? <p>When you serve someone, it's hard not to like and love them. It's hard to be mean to them. <p>JOHN 14:6</p>	<p>Verse reminder: "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." (John 14:6)</p> <p>What did we learn yesterday? (<i>Jesus is our Servant Leader</i>) What did Jesus do for His disciples? (<i>Washed their feet</i>)</p> <p>Today, we are going to talk about a big word: "sacrifice".</p> <p>What does it mean to "sacrifice"? (<i>Sacrifice is the act of giving up something valuable, such as time, resources, comfort, or money, for the sake of someone else. It involves a conscious choice to forfeit something for a greater cause or to fulfil a duty or atone for a wrong.</i>)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>A parent might sacrifice sleep to take care of a sick child</i> • <i>An athlete might make a sacrifice by missing social events or giving up eating certain foods to train for the Olympics</i> <p>Explaining the word: "ATONE": <i>In the Old Testament, animals were sacrificed on altars as a way of telling God they were sorry for the wrongs they had done. It was a way to restore a relationship with Him.</i></p> <p>What are some ways Jesus sacrificed Himself while He was here on earth? (<i>Left heaven where it is perfect and beautiful. He left His Father. He had no home of His own. He healed others. Wept with friends.
